

Getting to the University of Sydney's Darlington Centre

The Darlington centre is located on City Road and is indicated by the red circle in the diagram below.

By taxi from the City (recommended)

It will take 10 to 15 mins and cost about \$15. The Darlington Centre has its own driveway and the taxi can drop you off inside. Up to 4 passengers can fit in one taxi.

By bus from the City (not recommended)



Catching a bus in the city at rush hour is slightly problematic because you will not be allowed to pay in cash on the bus. You will have to purchase a pass at a newsagent. Look for a purple sign that says PrePay tickets sold here. A blue TravelTen which costs \$15.20 is the appropriate pass and can be shared by several people and is good for ten trips. For stops on **Parramatta Road** catch routes 412, 413, 435, 436, 437, 438, 440, 461, 480 from George Street or Railway Square. You can get off at the stop at Victoria Park and stroll through the park, or you can get off one stop later at the main gates to the university and walk through the University.

For stops on **City Road** (closest to Darlington Centre) catch routes 422, 423, 426, 428 from Castlereagh Street or Railway Square. You should get off two bus-stops after the overbridge with the green decorations on it.
